	Business Communication (CM1)	Two half-credit courses are required. Courses can be taken in Liberal Arts such as English literature, psychology, sociology, politics, history, etc.
	Corporate Finance Fundamentals (FN1)	FINC 3000 Managerial Finance FINC 3002 Dealership Financial Analysis
	Accounting Business Case (BC1)	To be eligible for a transfer credit in BC1, you must obtain transfer credits in FA1, FA2, FA3, CM1, MA1, MS1, FN1 and have a business degree or diploma. All requirements must be completed prior to enrolment in the CGA program.

**A grade of “65%” is required in each of the equivalent courses through the Bachelor of Applied Business – Automotive Management (AUTM) in order to obtain a transfer credit.**
