Martin Hayward, CGA – City Treasurer, Chief Financial Officer

Recently, the City Council of the City of London approved the appointment of Mr. Martin Hayward, CGA – the current director of financial planning and acting deputy city treasurer – as city treasurer, chief financial officer.



A certified general accountant since 1990 and a bachelor of arts degree holder, Mr. Hayward began his civil service career with a part-time job at the Public Utilities Commission in 1984 before a full time position opened in 1985. He worked his way through numerous city positions and departments over the next decade or more, including recreation, human resources, internal audit and finance.

During the early days of his career in the finance department he worked on a variety of high-profile projects, including the impacts of annexation, removal of sewer charges from the property tax base to utility bills, project lead on the selection and implementation of the City of London's ERP software and implementation of the strategic financial plan including identifying issues and surrounding downloading of services from the province.

He describes his new position simply to ensure Council receives good financial advice and to make sure the city maintains a firm financial standing. A balance of keeping the city financially solid and maintaining affordable taxes while balancing service requirements will be vital in moving forward in this challenging economy.

"We have had the opportunity to work with Martin in the past and he has always provided top-notch, professional responses to our concerns", said Gerry McCartney, CEO of the London Chamber of Commerce. "I think that anyone who works with Mr. Hayward will find him very engaging, thorough and well focused".
